1. Cape CARES has registered all team members with the US Embassy's SMART Traveler Program. This does not mean that you do not need to take your passport with you to Honduras. You will need your passport to get in and out of the country and back to the States.
2. Cape CARES has purchased international medical/evacuation insurance for all team members. You will receive an email from Seven Corners Ins. with an attachment providing your insurance card. Please print that out and take it with you to Honduras.
3. Please provide a family member and/or friend with the following information before you depart for Honduras. This will expedite their efforts to contact you if an emergency arises at home while you are in Honduras.
